

## Roland E. Teixeira de Mattos, MRICS, 60



In 2018, after 15 years at GE, Roland Teixeira rekindled with entrepreneurship (Mandalay) as business angel for Bizmotica (Al in Real Estate), 360XP (AR/VR) and CodeFever (Digital Education) whilst serving as non-executive director on the board of GE Europe NV (2018), GE Grid Solutions (2018) and de Doelen Steunfonds.

Alongside, Roland Teixeira, a chartered surveyor holding an executive master's in real estate from Solvay Brussels School, is chairing the <u>European Onshore Power Supply Association</u>.

From 2008 to 2017, Roland was Group CEO for GE in the Benelux (\$1.2bn, 2000 FTE), chairing the Benelux Board and leading growth, lobbying and innovation programs in Digital, Oil&Gas, Healthcare, Energy, Renewable Energy and Marine. Roland joined GE's Global Executive Group in 2011.

From 2014 to 2017, Roland led GE Marine's KA organisation in Europe and Middle East (\$1.3bn, 850FTE) with particular focus on offshore energy, services, lobbying and digital transformation.

Prior to GE, Roland Teixeira worked and held executive roles in France, Taiwan, UK, Switzerland, Hong Kong and Singapore.

Roland is a former board member of: VNO-NCW Rotterdam, AMCHAM Belgium, AMCHAM Rotterdam, GE-Port of Rotterdam Innovation Group.

As a former member of the Rotterdam Economic Board, Roland advised the Mayor of Rotterdam' office on economic and international issues.

Roland Teixeira operates MANDALAY destined to invest, represent and inform customers. Among its customers, Mandalay renders interim representation for Tractebel Offshore Renewables and co-invests, as marine growth channel in the VitalyX oil lubrification solution from Baker Hughes.
